**2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Contest**  
**REVISED Official Rules and Conditions of Eligibility**

**OVERVIEW:**

The Maryland State Lottery Agency (Lottery) is providing Lottery players, through a series of five (5) Preliminary drawings, five (5) Semi-Finalist drawings and one Grand Prize drawing event, with the opportunity to win a total of \$2,062,500\* in prizes in the \$25 Million Frenzy 2nd Chance Contest.

**Preliminary Drawings:** The Lottery will conduct five (5) preliminary drawings and select five (5) semi-finalists at each drawing, for a total of 25 semi-finalists. Each of the semi-finalists will receive \$1,000.

**Semi-Finalist Drawing Events:** The Lottery will conduct five (5) semi-finalist drawing events, one following each of the preliminary drawings. One finalist will be selected at each of the semi-finalist drawing events, for a total of five (5) finalists, to participate in the Grand Prize Drawing event.

**Grand Prize Drawing Event:** The drawing event for the Grand Prize will be held at an event in 2007 (date and time TBD). Each of the five finalists will win a prize: either \$2,500, or \$5,000, or \$10,000, or \$20,000 or the \$2,000,000\* Grand Prize.

(\*The \$2,000,000 Grand Prize will be paid as an annuity over 25 years unless the winner selects the cash option within 60 days from the date of claim. The cash option amount will be equivalent to the cost to purchase bonds to fund the annuity at the time of claiming.)

**HOW TO ENTER:**

To enter the \$25 Million Frenzy 2nd Chance Contest, send in any non-winning \$25 Million Frenzy or \$20 Million Mania Scratch-Off ticket with your name, address (and, if possible, phone number and/or e-mail address) on the back to:

Entries may be mailed by placing appropriate postage on the upper right hand corner of the back of the ticket or in an envelope no larger than 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" in any direction and must contain a Maryland postmark. Entries submitted should list one name only or the Lottery will choose which name is the semi-finalist. Each mailing will be considered as one entry, even if more than one \$25 Million Frenzy or \$20 Million Mania Scratch-Off ticket is enclosed. To be eligible for one of the five (5) semi-finalist drawings, entries must be received by 10:00 AM on the respective Deadline for Entries dates listed below.

**GRAND PRIZE**

**MARYLAND STATE FAIR**

To enter this second chance contest you must be 18 years or older, and you must be a legal resident of the United States. You may enter as often as you wish; however, only one contestant per household (anyone living at the same address) may be selected as a semi-finalist. In addition, no other members of a contestant's immediate family (spouse, child, parent or sibling) may be selected as a semi-finalist. This is a bonus game. This second chance contest is governed by these Official Rules and Conditions of Eligibility.

The Lottery reserves the right to reschedule any times and dates regarding this second chance contest, if necessary, without advance notice. In the event the Lottery receives an excessive number of entries for this promotion, the Lottery reserves the right to conduct one or more pre-promotion random drawing(s) to determine the final entries for the drawings.

**CLAIMING:**

**Semi-finalists, at the time they are notified, will be advised of claiming procedures.** All semi-finalists must complete a Lottery Claim Form, including Social Security number (SSN), and must provide proof of their SSN and must furnish photo I.D. proof of being at least 18 years of age. These prizes are bonus prizes. Applicable federal and state taxes will be withheld from the Grand Prize. In addition, applicable child support arrearages,

criminal restitution owed and other outstanding debts will be withheld from both the \$1,000 prizes and the Grand Prize. Further amounts may be owed. Winners are responsible for all taxes, including income taxes.

**OTHER OFFICIAL GAME RULES:**

All semi-finalists will be notified by the Lottery following the preliminary drawings via telephone and/or certified mail to confirm eligibility. In the event a semi-finalist cannot be confirmed or has not submitted required claiming documentation by a reasonable period after the preliminary drawing, the Lottery may select an alternate semi-finalist. Drawings may be televised.

By submitting an entry, you agree to appear at any Semi-Finalist and Grand Prize drawing events, including any drawing event that may be taped or televised, and to participate in any game for which you are selected or to send a proxy who will participate. The Lottery reserves the right to approve or reject any proxy designated by a contestant. All contestants at any taped or televised drawing event agree to behave in a reasonable, respectful and cooperative manner and to not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Contestants also agree to wear at any taped or televised drawing event clothing that contains no logos or writing, and the Lottery reserves the right to determine what clothing is acceptable for appearing on the taped or televised drawing event. The Lottery also reserves the right to require contestants to wear clothing provided by the Lottery. The Lottery reserves the right to appoint a proxy or a stand-in if the contestant's clothing or behavior is not acceptable, or as otherwise determined by the Lottery, in the Lottery's reasonable sole discretion. A "drawing" may include any random selection event.

To be eligible to win the Grand Prize drawing event, the five (5) finalists selected must be present and participate in the event, or taping of the event, on (exact date to be determined by the Lottery) or send a proxy. Any prize won by the proxy will be paid to the original semi-finalist who was selected to appear at the event.

By submitting an entry for this second chance contest, you consent and agree to the following: a) to publicity and to have your name, photo, and/or hometown aired on TV, radio, and other media and in other publicity, as well as used in Lottery publications and advertisements, Lottery mailings, and/or other Lottery-related activities including mailing lists, b) to participate in a check presentation ceremony as determined by the Lottery, c) to sign news and press release forms and d) to sign waivers and releases of all liability.

Employees of Trahan, Burden & Charles or the Lottery's broadcast stations, WBAL-TV, and/or any member of their immediate family living in the same residence are prohibited from participating in this second chance contest. Maryland law prohibits an officer or employee of the Maryland State Lottery Agency, or any individual who is a spouse, child, parent, or sibling of an officer or employee of the Maryland State Lottery Agency who resides in the same household as the officer or employee, from participating in this second chance contest.

Receipt of an entry will not be confirmed or returned. Once submitted, all entries become the property of the Lottery. At the conclusion of each drawing, all non-selected entries may be destroyed or used by the Lottery.

Participants release and hold harmless the Maryland State Lottery Agency, the Maryland State Lottery Commission, the State of Maryland and their members, agents, employees, and representatives ("MSLA"), from any liability arising out of participation in this second chance contest, or out of the use, misuse, or acceptance of a prize. MSLA is not responsible for any negligence of any person, or any claim, liability, injury, property loss, or other damage of or to participants, contestants, travelers, winners and/or their family members or guests arising from or in connection with either the use or misuse of prizes awarded or with participation in this second chance contest or in any event or occurrence related to this second chance contest.

The probability of winning a cash prize and of becoming a contestant will be determined by the number of entries received. Probabilities may change depending on the number of tickets in a game and the number of games included in any contest. The Lottery is not responsible for names announced or published in error. By participating in this 2nd Chance Contest, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and Conditions of Eligibility, in addition to any applicable laws and regulations including the Maryland State Lottery Law and Regulations. The Lottery will make all determinations concerning the validity of entries, winners, and other decisions required under this second chance contest. The decision of the Lottery shall be final. The Lottery reserves the right to modify, without notice, any rule and any times and dates when circumstances warrant, and when it is in the best interest of the Lottery to do so.
