ANSWER:

a) Number of internal and external IP addresses and hosts Internal IP Addresses: Approximately 500 on 12 subnets

Internal Hosts: Approximately 25 servers External IP Addresses: 14 on one subnet

External Hosts: One web site and six State / vendor hosts

b) Number of end points
Approximately 300 end points (desktops / laptops)

c) Number and types of firewalls and IDS/IPS in scope for the review

Number of firewalls: Three

Type of firewalls: Cisco ASA5525-x, Cisco ASA5520 and Cisco ASA5505

Number of IPS: Two

Type of IPS: Cisco IPS4240 and Cisco FireSIGHT VM

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d) Number and types of wireless access points

Number of wireless access points: Eight

Type of wireless access points: Cisco Meraki MR24 and MR34
