JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge Second-Chance Promotion
Drawing Rules – REVISED 5-21-2020 – Changing Last 2 Drawing Dates

OVERVIEW:

Beginning any time on Monday, March 23, 2020, until 11:59:59 PM on Monday, October 12, 2020, players can enter the **JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge** Second-Chance Promotion (“Promotion”) offered by the Maryland State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (“Lottery” or “Maryland Lottery”) for a chance to win one (1) of four (4) prizes of a trip to Las Vegas, Nevada (“Trip Prize”) on or about spring 2021 to participate in the **JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge** (“LOTTERY CHALLENGE”). The Lottery will conduct a series of four (4) second-chance drawings (“Drawings” or “Drawing”) throughout the Promotion to select four (4) winners, one (1) winner for each Drawing. See below for more information.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

To participate, enter at mdlottery.com/jamesbondlotterychallenge, through **My Lottery Rewards (“MLR”)** at mdlottery.com/rewards, or through the **MLR App** any non-winning Maryland Lottery® JAMES BOND 007™ scratch-off ticket (Game #489) and/or any other ticket specified by the Lottery (singular “Ticket”, plural “Tickets”).

For each Drawing: Entries must be entered for a specific Drawing by 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time on the announced Drawing Entry Deadline date to be eligible for that Drawing. (In these Rules, all times are Eastern Time.) Entries are not cumulative. Each Drawing must be entered individually to participate in that Drawing. **See the Drawing Chart below for Drawing Number, Drawing Entry Deadlines, Drawing Dates, Number of Winners, Prizes, and Claiming Deadlines.**

A Drawing may include any random selection event. These are bonus Drawings and bonus prizes.

Internet access and a valid email address are required to enter this Promotion and its Drawings. Mailed entries will not be accepted. You may enter as often as you like; however, you may only win once throughout the Promotion.

You do not need to keep your original ticket in order to claim your prize if you win. (Players and winners are sometimes referred to as “you” and “your”.) A qualifying entry is one (1) Ticket. A Ticket may only be used to enter one time. Players will automatically receive one (1) entry per Ticket into the Promotion, and progress towards MLR achievements.

To enter, you must be 18 years of age or older. All winners and guests must be at least 18 years of age. The LOTTERY CHALLENGE is an age restricted prize, please see the [JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge Official Contest Details](#) for complete details.

*Winners and alternates whose claiming deadlines occur during the state of emergency that began on March 5, 2020 will be able to claim their Trip Prize for up to 30 days after the state of emergency has been lifted. If an Alternate winner is needed, they will have 30 days from the time of notification to claim their Trip Prize. The processing of checks during the state of emergency may take up to 30 days.

All winners, including alternate winners (“Alternates” or “Alternate”), must claim your prize by 4:30 PM on the respective claiming deadlines shown above.

PRIZE DESCRIPTION:

Trip Prize:

Four (4) winners, one (1) from each of the four (4) Drawings, will be selected to win a Trip Prize. The Trip Prize will take place on or about Spring of 2021. The LOTTERY CHALLENGE will take place at a time yet to be determined. Each Trip Prize will include:

- A five (5) day, four (4) night trip for two (winner and one guest) to Las Vegas, Nevada;
- Roundtrip coach airfare for up to two (2) people on a major airline, as defined by the Federal Aviation Administration, from any U.S. International airport to McCarran International Airport in Las Vegas, inclusive of all associated security fees, taxes and surcharges. (It is the responsibility of the winner and guest to comply with the REAL ID Act as applicable to winner’s and guest’s air travel. If the winner chooses not to fly, Contractor (defined below) shall provide that winner a cash allowance toward another mode of transportation to travel to the hotel in Las Vegas.);
- Ground transfers between McCarran International Airport and the destination hotel and, if necessary, between Scientific Games International, Inc. (“SGI”) on behalf of itself and its wholly-owned subsidiary MDI Entertainment, LLC (“MDI”)(collectively, “Contractor”) hosted events;
- Accommodations of one (1) double occupancy 4-star or better hotel room for four (4) nights (room and room tax only) in Las Vegas, Nevada. The winner or guest must have a valid credit card or shall be required to post a cash deposit for incidentals to check into the hotel;
- One thousand dollars (\$1,000) spending money for the winner to be provided by check and mailed two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled trip departure date;
- Admission to the LOTTERY CHALLENGE theater/venue for the winner and guest, or duly authorized proxy. The winner shall have one (1) chance to participate in four (4) rounds of the LOTTERY CHALLENGE for an opportunity to win a cash prize of up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more as described below. In addition, the winner or designated proxy shall also participate in a Bonus Event for a chance to win a bonus cash prize up to \$100,000 as further described in the [JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge Official Contest Details](#);
- The Trip Prize does not include mileage, insurance, gratuities, meals, parking fees, baggage fees, alcoholic beverages, personal expenses such as telephone calls, valet service, laundry, incidentals and the like, revision or cancellation fees which may be charged by the hotel or other suppliers, or any other items not expressly specified herein;
- Trip Prize may not be sold. Trip Prize may not be used by anyone other than the Trip Prize winner without the Lottery Director’s written approval;
- Contractor may substitute a prize of equal or better quality upon the written approval of the Lottery.

Estimated Trip Prize Value: \$7,500

JAMES BOND LOTTERY CHALLENGE

Each of the four (4) winners (or an assigned proxy) shall participate as a finalist in the LOTTERY CHALLENGE together with finalists from other participating lottery jurisdictions. The LOTTERY CHALLENGE consists of two (2) events. In the first event, each finalist will participate in a Stage Show Event (“Show”) in a series of mini-games for the chance to win cash prizes. There are four (4) rounds (each a “Round”). Each Round will be played separately. In the second event, separate from the Show, finalists will also participate in a Tournament (“Bonus Event”) where they will compete for a bonus cash prize. Additional Conditions:

- Winner must be twenty-one (21) years or older per Nevada State Law to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE. If you are under the age of twenty-one (21), you may pre-designate a proxy, or one will be chosen for you, to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE on your behalf. You will receive any cash prize(s) won by the proxy on the LOTTERY CHALLENGE (less applicable tax withholdings);
- Winner’s guest may sit with the winner but will not be eligible to be a participant in the LOTTERY CHALLENGE unless they have been designated as the winner’s proxy;
- The winner may not modify or change his or her proxy once he or she designates one;
- Winner is solely responsible for the actions of the guest who accompanies the winner on the Trip Prize;
- The winner and their guest are subject to a background investigation prior to the LOTTERY CHALLENGE event;
- Winner will be mailed the official event details concerning the LOTTERY CHALLENGE prior to their Trip Prize departure;

- Contractor will issue a W-2G to you for the prize amounts won during the LOTTERY CHALLENGE and provide a copy to the Maryland Lottery;
- Prizes won during the LOTTERY CHALLENGE will be mailed to you within twenty-one (21) business days after the winner's departure from Las Vegas;
- All prizes won by you will be subject to the Maryland Lottery's outstanding State Obligations procedures (See Claiming below regarding outstanding State Obligations).

The **JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge** is administered by MDI Entertainment, LLC and Scientific Games International, Inc. (collectively "the **Contractor**"). Any questions regarding the **JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge**, including questions regarding the assignment of proxies, prize payments, and tax liability or withholding for cash prizes, should be directed to MDI Entertainment, LLC at 1-800-201-0108. Participation in the **JAMES BOND Lottery Challenge** may be subject to other local, state, and federal laws, including the laws of the State of Nevada.

CLAIMING:

You will be advised, at the time of notification, of claiming procedures and reminded of claiming deadlines. Claiming deadlines for winners, including Alternates, are included in the Drawing Chart above. All winners must claim your prize in person **by 4:30 PM of the claiming deadline date** listed in the Drawing Chart above.

If a winner has been disqualified, or by the relevant claiming deadline has not claimed, submitted all required documentation and information, including completing associated waivers, and been confirmed and validated as eligible, then an Alternate may be selected. The winner and their guest are subject to a background investigation prior to the Trip Prize, along with the eligibility verification. A decision to replace a winner with an Alternate is within the sole discretion and judgement of the Maryland Lottery. Once the decision to proceed with an Alternate is made, the person who was previously selected as a winner is no longer entitled to a prize. Alternates must claim by 4:30 PM of the claiming deadline designated for that Alternate.

Winners must claim your prize as follows:

- 1) You must claim your prize in person at the Lottery's Baltimore Customer Resource Center, Montgomery Park Business Center, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Suite 330, Baltimore, MD 21230.
- 2) Winners must furnish photo I.D. proof of being at least 18 years of age.
- 3) If you win a prize and you owe State Obligations, which include but are not limited to child support and/or certain other obligations to a State agency or other governmental entity, then:
 - a. If you owe less than \$1,000 (the cash portion of the Trip Prize) the cash portion of the Trip Prize (\$1,000) will be applied first to those State Obligations.
 - b. If you owe more than \$1,000, you have options:
 - i. The Lottery will apply the \$1,000 of the prize to your State Obligations and you pay the rest within 5 days; or
 - ii. You may decline the Trip Prize and sign a Refusal of Prize and Waiver and Release of All Liability, and an Alternate may be selected; or
 - iii. If you do not pay off all of your outstanding State Obligations within five (5) business days of claiming the prize, then you will be disqualified and an Alternate may be selected. See MLR Terms of Use for further provisions.
- 4) In the event of a winner's death or inability to partake of the Trip Prize, the Lottery will make a determination about the awarding of the Trip Prize. The Lottery's decision will be final.
- 5) You do not have the option to request or receive a substitute or equivalent prize for any prize.

Contractor will completely fulfill the Trip Prize, including all cash prizes won during the LOTTERY CHALLENGE. Contractor will pay the estimated State and Federal tax withholdings for the Trip Prize, including all cash prizes won during the LOTTERY CHALLENGE, and you will receive a W-2G form from Contractor for these prizes. All amounts paid to you or on your behalf will be included in your reportable income. You will be taxed on those amounts. All winners are responsible for all taxes, including income taxes.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

If the winner is traveling via air and fails to appear at the designated time and place of departure (excluding flight delays), Contractor will use reasonable efforts to reschedule the flight at the expense of the winner. If Contractor is not able to reschedule the flight, then the winner will not participate in the trip portion of the Trip Prize (air travel, lodging and ground transfers) with the exception of the \$1,000 cash portion of the Trip Prize, less any tax withholdings; however, a proxy will be appointed to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE for the winner, and the winner shall receive any prizes won by the proxy (less applicable tax withholdings and debt set-off).

If the winner fails to check into the hotel when he or she arrives in Las Vegas, Contractor will use reasonable efforts to reschedule the reservation. If Contractor is unable to reschedule the reservation the balance of the trip portion of the Trip Prize shall be forfeited with the exception of the return air travel and the \$1,000 cash portion, less any tax withholdings; however, a proxy will be appointed to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE for the winner, and the winner shall receive any prizes won by the proxy (less any applicable tax withholdings and debt set-off).

If the winner fails to arrive for his or her scheduled participation in the LOTTERY CHALLENGE, the winner forfeits the right to personally participate in the LOTTERY CHALLENGE as a Finalist; however, a proxy will be appointed to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE for the winner, and the winner shall receive any prizes won by the proxy (less any tax withholdings and debt set-off).

In the event a winner is unable to attend the trip after the trip has been booked, the balance of the Trip Prize shall be forfeited with the exception of the \$1,000 cash portion of the Trip Prize (less any applicable tax withholdings); however, a proxy will be appointed to play the LOTTERY CHALLENGE, and the winner will receive any prizes won by the proxy (less any tax withholdings and debt set-off).

If winner ends participation in the Trip Prize, either the whole Trip Prize or any portion of the Trip Prize, after claiming said prize, winner shall be deemed to have taken ownership of the entire Trip Prize, and the full claimed value of the entire Trip Prize (including the value of the travel portion) shall be reported to the IRS. Winner will be responsible for any additional state or federal taxes resulting from the claimed Trip Prize, above and beyond those taxes withheld, reported and paid on the winner's behalf by Contractor to the appropriate agencies.

In addition to those included in the Terms of Use, the following may not participate in the Promotion or its Drawings: Any officer or employee of Danjaq, LLC and or Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Studios, Inc. and/or any of their parent companies, subsidiaries, or subcontractors; and/or any member or such officer or employee's immediate family (spouse or domestic partner, child, parent, parent-in-law, or sibling) who resides in the same residence as the officer or employee.
