COVID-19 Vaccination + Booster Shot Promotion: February 15, 2022 – May 3, 2022

Drawing Rules

OVERVIEW:

Beginning on February 15, 2022 until May 3, 2022, the Maryland State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (“Lottery” or “Maryland Lottery”) is offering a \$2 Million VaxCash 2.0 Promotion (“Promotion”). The Promotion provides eligible individuals a chance to win one (1) \$500,000 cash prize, one (1) of ten (10) \$50,000 cash prizes, or one (1) \$1 Million cash grand prize. Individuals who are Maryland residents, 18 years of age or older, and have received all of their COVID-19 shots in Maryland (not at a Federal Facility unless obtained at a VA medical facility in Maryland) will be automatically entered into the Promotion.

The Lottery will conduct a series of twelve (12) drawings (“Drawings”, singular “Drawing”) throughout the Promotion. One prize of \$500,000 will be awarded to kick-off the Promotion (“Kick-Off Drawing”), one prize of \$50,000 will be awarded for ten weeks at each weekly Drawing (“Weekly Drawing”, plural “Weekly Drawings”), and one prize of \$1 Million will be awarded for the grand-prize Drawing (“Grand-Prize Drawing”). You may only win once during the Promotion.

For each Drawing: Entries, which are automatic upon an individual over the age of 18 receiving all of your COVID-19 shots in Maryland, i.e. two shots Moderna + booster, **or** two shots Pfizer + booster, **or** one shot Johnson & Johnson + booster (the booster may be of any COVID-19 vaccine), and all of your vaccination information including the booster has been received and accepted as valid by the Immunization Information System, ImmuNet (“Entry”), must be entered by 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time (in these Rules, all times are Eastern Time) for the day prior to a Drawing in order to be included in the next Drawing.

These are bonus Drawings. On February 15, 2022, one winner will be selected in the Kick-Off Drawing to win \$500,000. Between February 22, 2022 and April 26, 2022, one winner will be selected each week in the Weekly Drawing to each win \$50,000. On May 3, 2022, one winner will be selected to win \$1 Million in the Grand-Prize Drawing.

DRAWINGS:

Prior to each Drawing, Maryland’s Department of Health (“MDH”) will provide the Maryland Lottery with the total number of Entries for that Drawing; the MDH will assign a number to each Entry. Each vaccinated individual is anonymized by number. Neither the MDH nor the Veterans Health Administration of the United States Department of Veteran Affairs (“VA”) will provide the Lottery with any personally identifying information about any vaccinated individual before the Lottery conducts the Drawing and prior to a winner signing a “VaxCash 2.0 Promotion Authorization Form” (“MDH Authorization Form”).

The Lottery will conduct the Drawings using a random number generator based on the total number of Entries for that Drawing. For each Drawing, the Lottery’s random number generator will select five (5) numbers, one (1) winner and four (4) alternates.

The MDH will contact you if your identifying number is anonymously drawn as the winner. If you do not want to claim the prize, you may let the MDH know that you decline it, and the MDH will never provide your personally identifying information to the Lottery. The MDH will repeat the process with the first alternate winner, and, if necessary, a successive alternate winner.

A Drawing is a single drawing within the Promotion. Note that drawing, Drawing or Drawings may refer to any random selection event. Only Entries, as defined above, are included in the anonymized number set making up that Drawing’s Drawing pool.

CLAIMING:

Authorization to Release Information to Lottery

For each Drawing, the Lottery will tell the MDH the winner’s number(s). The MDH will use that number to retrieve the winner’s contact information. The MDH will notify the winner(s) of each Drawing. The MDH will request the winner to complete a written MDH Authorization Form and return it to MDH, permitting the MDH to disclose to the Lottery the individual’s name, address, email address, telephone number(s), and COVID-19 booster and vaccination status. The winner will have 14 business days from the date their entry is selected to complete in its entirety and return the Executed MDH Authorization Form to MDH. The Lottery requires this information to confirm a winner’s eligibility and to validate their entry. Maryland’s Department of Budget and Management (“DBM”) requires aggregate information from the Lottery of the prizes paid out so that DBM can report that aggregate information to the Treasury Department of the Federal government. If the winner does not respond to MDH’s attempts to contact them or the winner does not complete in its entirety and return to MDH the MDH Authorization Form within time and date listed on the Drawing Schedule under “Executed MDH Authorization Form,” then the winner will be disqualified from that Drawing and the process will be repeated with the first alternate winner, and if necessary, a successive alternate.

Lottery Validation

When the MDH receives the winner’s completed MDH Authorization Form within time specified in the above Drawing Schedule, the MDH will notify the Lottery of the winner’s name, address, email address, telephone number(s), and COVID-19 booster and vaccination status. If the winner is validated by the Lottery, aggregate information of the prizes awarded in the Promotion will be provided to DBM in accordance with applicable laws surrounding the prize funds. Although this information must be provided to DBM and reported to the Treasury Department of the Federal Government, Maryland’s Public Information Act otherwise prohibits the Lottery from disclosing this information without the winner’s consent. A winner may

choose to remain anonymous. Each winner must complete a Lottery Claim Form within time specified in the Drawing Schedule above, including SSN or TIN, and provide proof of your SSN or TIN and must furnish photo I.D. proof of being a Maryland resident and at least 18 years of age.

Ineligible Entries

The following are prohibited from claiming any prize in this Promotion:

1. Any Commission member, or any officer or employee of the Lottery, or any individual who is a spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, parent-in-law, or sibling of a Commission member or of an officer or employee of the Lottery or the Commission who lives in the same principal residence as the Commission member, officer or employee;
2. Any officer or employee of any Lottery vendor (including the Lottery's advertising agencies, broadcast station, on-line gaming contractor, instant ticket contractor(s), SGI, and/or any of their parent companies, subsidiaries, or subcontractors, and/or any member of such officer's or employee's immediate family (spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, parent-in-law, or sibling) who resides in the same residence as the officer or employee;
3. Any participant in the Lottery's Voluntary Exclusion Program or individual who has otherwise requested in writing to be excluded from this Promotion;
4. Any officer, official, contractor or employee who assisted in the creation of this Promotion, or in carrying out any of the Drawings, or such officer's, official's or employee's immediate family (spouse or domestic partner, child, parent, parent-in-law, or sibling) who resides in the same residence as the officer, official or employee; and
5. Any individual who is currently confined in a local detention center, state correctional facility, or by the criminal justice system.

State Obligations

If you win a prize and you owe any State Obligations, then the cash prize will be applied first to your unpaid State Obligations. The total amount of cash won, less tax withholdings and any State Obligations, will be issued to you. "State Obligation" includes, but is not limited to, child support and debt owed to a State agency or other governmental entity.

Taxes

You are responsible for all taxes, including income taxes, for any prize won. You will receive a 1099-MISC form from the Lottery for the prize won. All amounts or values paid to you, or paid on your behalf, will be included in the taxable income the Lottery will report on your 1099-MISC. You will be taxed on those amounts. The minimum required Federal and State taxes will be withheld from all cash prizes over \$5,000; further amounts may be owed.

Claim Prize

You will be advised, at the time of the Lottery's notification, of claiming procedures, and be reminded of claiming deadlines.

Winners must claim their prize as follows:

- **By 4:30 PM of the claiming deadline date** as identified on the above Drawing Schedule and as otherwise described within these Rules:
 - Either at Maryland Lottery's Baltimore Customer Resource Center, Montgomery Park Business Center, 1800 Washington Blvd., Suite 330, Baltimore, MD 21230 ("Maryland Lottery Headquarters"); or
 - By mail, email or fax with documentation as required by the Lottery, including any waiver and release of liability for that type of prize and for that Drawing.
- If a winner refuses the Prize, has been disqualified, or by the relevant claiming deadline has not claimed, submitted all required documentation, and information, including completing associated forms, and been confirmed and validated as eligible, then an Alternate winner may be selected.

- Alternate winners must claim by 4:30 PM on the claiming deadline as identified on the above Drawing Schedule.

Checks will be provided by the Comptroller of Maryland's Office. It is expected that checks will be mailed to winners within 30 calendar days from when a winner claims their prize.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

A decision to replace a winner with an alternate is within the sole discretion and judgment of the Maryland Lottery. After the Lottery decides to proceed with an alternate, the person who was previously selected as a winner is no longer entitled to the prize.

Entries are only those as defined above. The Federal government will not provide the Maryland Department of Health with a list of Marylanders who were provided vaccinations or a COVID-19 booster at Federal facilities so these individuals are generally not eligible. The VA; however, has provided information concerning individuals vaccinated and provided with a booster shot at VA medical facilities located in Maryland to MDH to be included in ImmuNet. It is not possible for individuals to submit their records to the Maryland Department of Health; ImmuNet is updated by healthcare providers including pharmacies that received Federal funds to implement their COVID-19 vaccination programs (e.g. CVS and Walgreens).

In the event of a winner's death or inability to partake of the prize, the Lottery will make a determination about the awarding of the prize. The Lottery's decision will be final.

If you refuse a prize, you lose all right to claim or receive the prize.

In its sole discretion, the Maryland Lottery may change any of these Rules, other applicable requirements, rules, and/or references to other applicable laws (which may change) at any time.

You and any potential beneficiary may not assert any right or remedy on account of any disqualification, or other action. The Lottery will determine if a winner will be allowed to receive a prize.

The probability of winning any Drawing or promotion prize will be determined by the number of eligible and valid entries submitted for a specific Drawing or promotion.

Drawing dates and promotion dates are subject to change or modification as determined by the Maryland Lottery.

The Lottery will make all determinations concerning the validity of entries, winners, and other decisions required under any Drawing or promotion. The decision of the Lottery shall be final.

The Maryland Lottery is not responsible or liable for any damages, injury, illness, or loss of life resulting from any prize won.

The Lottery reserves the right to reschedule any times and dates regarding any aspect of any Drawing or promotion without advance notice. The Lottery reserves the right to void any Drawing without advance notice and to conduct a new Drawing if the Lottery, in its sole discretion, determines it is necessary to maintain the integrity of the Drawing.

You will sign any forms including a "VaxCash 2.0 Promotion Authorization Form" provided by MDH officials, and affidavits of eligibility required by the Lottery. To the extent you consent to publicity, you also agree to sign any news and press release forms as required by the Lottery.

You agree and acknowledge that you are aware of the following facts: any prize, and each portion of a prize, involves certain inherent risks, dangers and hazards that can result in injury to property and/or persons, and serious personal injury, illness, or death. You freely agree to assume and accept all known and unknown risks of injury (including, but not limited to, personal injury, illness, death, and property damage) arising out of any prize.

If any discrepancy exists between these Rules and other material describing the Promotion or anything related thereto, these Rules shall prevail.
