GAME SHOW EXPERIENCE Second-Chance Promotion
Drawing Rules

OVERVIEW:

Beginning on Friday, August 21, 2026, at 00:00:00 AM Eastern Time (ET), until 11:59:59 PM on Monday, February 8, 2027, ("Promotion Period") players can enter the GAME SHOW EXPERIENCE Second-Chance Promotion ("Promotion") offered by the Maryland State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency ("Maryland Lottery" or "Lottery") through Maryland Lottery® My Lottery Rewards™ ("MLR") for the chance to win cash and a trip prize package. This Promotion will consist of six (6) drawings ("Drawings" or "Drawing"), and the Lottery will select one (1) winner ("Trip Winner" or "Winner") during each Drawing. A total of six (6) Trip Winners will be selected to win a Trip to Los Angeles, California to play the GAME SHOW EXPERIENCE and have the opportunity to win a share of potential cash prizes of up to \$10,000,000.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Players can enter at mdlottery.com/promotion or mdlottery.com/rewards or through the **My Lottery Rewards ("MLR") App** non-winning The Price Is Right™ Scratch-Off tickets (game #813), and/or any other ticket specified by the Maryland Lottery, purchased during the Promotion Period (each a "Ticket"). Each Ticket entered will generate one (1) entry into the Promotion, as well as progress toward active MLR achievements. A Ticket may only be used once to enter the Promotion.

Entries are not cumulative and will not carry over from each Drawing to the next. Entries must be entered by 11:59:59 PM by the announced Drawing Entry Deadline date in order to be eligible for that Drawing. (In these Drawing Rules, all times are Eastern Time ("ET").) See the **Drawings Chart** below for Drawing Number, Drawing Entry Start Date, Drawing Entry Deadline Date, Drawing Date, and Claiming Deadline Date for Winners and alternate winners ("Alternate(s)", "Alt."). A Drawing may include any random selection event. This is a bonus drawing, and the prizes are bonus prizes.

All Winners, including Alternates, must claim their prize by 4:30 PM ET on the respective claiming deadline. All entries received after the final Drawing Entry Deadline of 11:59:59 PM, February 8, 2027, will be ineligible and void.

Internet access and a valid email address are required for entry into the Promotion and its Drawings. Mailed entries will not be accepted. To enter and to win, players must be 18 years of age or older. Players may enter the Promotion as many times as they want, however, a Player may only win one time throughout the entire Promotion, and only one Winner per household/residence (as registered in MLR at the time of the Drawing) is allowed throughout the Promotion.

All Winners' names and town/city of residence will be posted on the Past Drawings & Winners page on the MLR website, and the Maryland Lottery Promotions page, and may be included in the Maryland Lottery's press releases, promotional emails, and/or social media posts.

PRIZE DESCRIPTION:

The Trip Prize is a five (5)-day, four (4)-night trip for two (2) (the Trip Winner and one (1) guest "Guest"), to Los Angeles, California to participate in the GAME SHOW EXPERIENCE ("GSE" and "GSE Event") for a chance to win a share of potential Cash Prizes of up to \$10,000,000. Trip date shall occur during or around the **Fall of 2027**.

Each Trip Prize includes:

- Roundtrip coach airfare for up to two (2) people from any U.S. international airport in the 48 U.S. contiguous states, Hawaii, Alaska, and Puerto Rico to Los Angeles, California-area airport (inclusive of all associated security fees, taxes and surcharges);
- Ground transfers between destination airport and the destination hotel;
- One (1) double occupancy room accommodations (room and room tax only) at a 3-star or better hotel in Los Angeles, California for four (4) nights;
- \$1,000 spending money in the form of a check;
- Admission for Trip Winner and Guest to the Welcome Reception;
- Admission to a taping of *The Price Is Right* TV game show;
- Trip Winner and Guest will be transported with other Trip Winners and Guests to a planned group excursion in or around Los Angeles;
- Transportation to the GSE Event venue for the Trip Winner and Guest;

- Admission to the GSE Event venues for the Trip Winners and Guests;
- Trip Winners, or duly authorized proxy participants (“Proxy”), shall have one (1) chance to participate in the GSE Event, as further described below, for a chance to win a share of cash prizes, that can total up to \$10,000,000 (“Cash Prizes”). The Trip Winner’s Guest may join the Trip Winner at the GSE Event, but will not be eligible to a participant in the GSE Event, unless the Guest has been duly appointed as the Trip Winner’s Proxy.

Estimated Trip Prize value: \$13,098.59 (this amount includes federal and state tax withholdings based on 2026 withholdings rates. The Trip Prize valuation is subject to change.

GAME SHOW EXPERIENCE EVENT OVERVIEW
The GSE Event shall be conducted according to event and security procedures generated by Scientific Games, LLC (“SG”) and its third-party underwriters (“GSE Event and Security Procedures”). Each Trip Winner (“Contestant”), (or an assigned Proxy) shall participate as a Contestant in the GSE Event together, with Contestants from other participating lottery jurisdictions. The GSE Event shall consist of rounds (“Round(s)”) themed from each of the three TV games shows: <i>THE PRICE IS RIGHT</i>®, <i>FAMILY FEUD</i>®, and <i>PRESS YOUR LUCK</i>®, for a chance to win a share of Cash Prizes of up to \$10,000,000: Round 1: PUNCH A BUNCH™ – Cash Prizes range from \$500 to \$2,500 Round 2: THE BIG WHEEL – Cash Prizes range from \$50 to \$2,000 Round 3: PLINKO® – Cash Prizes range from \$500 to \$30,000 Round 4: FAMILY FEUD® – Cash Prizes range from zero (\$0) to \$9,700 Round 5: PRESS YOUR LUCK® – Cash Prizes range from \$200,000 to \$10,000,000 and are awarded as follows: - A Round 5 finalist (“Finalist”) will have a chance to win between \$100,000 and \$5,000,000; and - Separately, a Cash Prize equal to the amount won by the Finalist in Round 5, will be awarded and split among all the other Contestants. For example, if the Finalist wins \$5,000,000 in Round 5, the other Contestants will receive, and split equally, a separate \$5,000,000. Final event details (“GSE Event Details”) explaining how the GSE Event will be conducted will be provided to Trip Winner after they claim their Prize. The information provided for the Rounds is subject to change until finalization of the official rules, as part of the GSE Event Details. All Cash Prizes in the GSE Event are underwritten by either SG, third parties, or both. All GSE Event Cash Prizes shall be awarded and paid out as lump sum payments, less tax withholdings. SG reserves the right to modify specific game play, provided such change does not result in a lower expected payout for the Contestant for the modified portion.

The GSE Event is not scheduled for television broadcast or any form of public exhibition.

The GSE Event is being administered by SG. Any questions regarding the GSE Event, including questions regarding the assignment of proxies, GSE Event Cash Prize payments, and tax liability or withholding for GSE Event Cash Prizes, will be directed to an SG Prize Coordinator at time of Trip Prize claim. Participation in the GSE Event may be subject to other local, state and federal laws, including the laws of the State of California.

FremantleMedia North America, Inc. ("Fremantle"), or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates or licensors (its parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, and licensors are collectively referred to hereinafter as, the "Fremantle Entities") are not sponsors or administrators of the GSE Event.

The Trip Prize does **not** include personal expenses, including but not limited to: mileage, insurance, gratuities, meals, parking fees, baggage fees, alcoholic beverages, personal expenses – such as telephone calls, valet service, laundry, incidentals and the like, revision or cancellation fees that may be charged by the hotel or other suppliers, or any other items not expressly specified herein. Personal expenses are the responsibility of the Trip Winner and Guest.

CLAIMING:

Winners will be advised, at the time of notification, of claiming procedures and reminded of claiming deadlines. Claiming deadlines for Winners and Alternates are included in the **Drawings Chart** above.

You do not need to keep your original Ticket in order to claim your prize. (Players and Winners are sometimes referred to as "you" and "your".)

If a Winner has been disqualified, or by the relevant claiming deadline has not claimed, submitted all required documentation and information, and been confirmed and validated as eligible, then an Alternate Winner may be selected. Alternates must claim by 4:30 PM on the claiming deadline designated for that Alternate. A decision to replace a Winner is within the sole discretion and judgement of the Maryland Lottery. Once the decision to proceed with an Alternate is made, the person who was previously selected as a Winner is no longer entitled to the prize.

You do not have the option to request or receive a substitute or equivalent prize or cash for any Prize.

Winners must claim their prize in person, unless specified by the Lottery upon notification, by **4:30 PM of the claiming deadline date listed in the Drawings Chart**, at the Maryland Lottery Baltimore Customer Resource Center, Montgomery Park Business Center, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Suite 330, Baltimore, MD 21230.

Once validated by the Lottery, the Contractor will fulfill the Trip Prizes. Trip Prize fulfillment shall include the scheduling and coordination of all travel, hotel accommodations, and ground transfers.

Each Trip Winner and Guest is subject to a background investigation, derived from public information, prior to departure to the GSE Event, conducted by SG Security, with the consent of the Trip Winner and Guest. The Trip Winner or Guest must have a valid credit card or shall be required to post cash deposit for incidentals to check into the hotel. The Trip Winner or Guest must be eighteen (18) years of age or older in order to participate in the GSE Event. The age requirement to check into a hotel in California is twenty-one (21), therefore the Trip Winner or

Guest must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older. Trip Winner and Guest shall be required to comply with the Department of Homeland Security's ("DHS") REAL ID Act and all other programs in order to attend the Event. For more information, please see [DHS's REAL ID webpage](#). If applicable, Trip Winner and Guest shall be required to follow all health and safety protocols as instructed by the Event's staff and volunteers, and all federal, state, and local guidelines.

The Trip Winner will be mailed, via signature-required method, the GSE Event Details concerning the GSE Event with their final travel documents and the \$1,000 spending money, in the form of a check (less any outstanding debt setoff), two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled trip departure date.

The Contractor will fulfill all GSE Event Cash Prizes that are awarded in connection with the Trip Prizes, except as prohibited by law. SG will issue an IRS Tax Form W-2G for the prize amounts won during the GSE Event. The payment of the GSE Event Cash Prizes awarded to each Contestant during the GSE Event are the sole responsibility of SG, third parties, or both, subject to the terms outlined here. GSE Event Cash Prize awards are not considered won by the Contestant, and are not payable, unless and until the third party underwriter (the "Risk Counterparty Representatives") of such Cash Prize payouts, and SG's Event Auditor, certify that the GSE Event has been conducted appropriately and in accordance with the official Event and Security Procedures, that a Contestant has validly won the GSE Event Cash Prize award pursuant to the official GSE Event Details, and the Prize Winner is entitled to receive the GSE Event Cash Prize award. The Risk Counterparty Representatives will then be required to pay the GSE Event Cash Prize awards to the Prize Winners. Participating Lotteries shall have no liability for any GSE Event Cash Prize amounts awarded collectively in the GSE Event and the third-party underwriter of such Prizes (where applicable) has accepted the obligation to pay the GSE Event Cash Prize to the Prize Winners. All GSE Event Cash Prizes won by the Contestants will be subject to the Maryland Lottery's debt setoff procedures. The total amount of Cash Prizes won during the GSE Event by the Prize Winner (less the tax withholdings), will be paid to the Prize Winner by Contractor within thirty (30) business days after the official conclusion of the GSE Event in Los Angeles, California, but not later than December 31, 2027.

The Trip Prize is not for resale, but may be transferred once, prior to the trip being booked, with approval from the Lottery and the Contractor.

As a further bonus, the Maryland Lottery will pay the required estimated State and Federal tax withholdings for the Trip Prize. Further amounts may be owed by the Trip Winner, and if so, such amount(s) shall be paid by the Trip Winner. The payment of tax withholdings could result in additional Federal and State tax liability being due for the Trip Winner. All amounts paid to the Trip Winner, or on the Trip Winner's behalf, will be included in the Trip Winner's reportable income. Trip Winner is responsible for all taxes, including income taxes in excess of withholdings paid by the Lottery. The Trip Winner will be provided with a W-2G by the Lottery for the value of the Trip Prize.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

Failure to comply with any of the official promotion and/or GSE Event Details, promotion and/or GSE Event and Security Procedures, any other guidelines, or codes of conduct set forth by SG's, may result in a Contestant's disqualification at SG's sole and absolute discretion and/or the revocation of any Cash Prize won during the GSE.

If a Trip Winner is traveling via air and fails to appear at the designated time of and place of departure (excluding flight delays), SG will use reasonable efforts to reschedule the flight at the expense of the Trip Winner. If SG is not able to reschedule the flight, then the spending money portion of the Trip Prize, less any tax withholdings, and the Proxy Procedure defined below will apply.

If the Trip Winner fails to check in to the hotel when he or she arrives in Los Angeles, California, SG will use reasonable efforts to reschedule the reservation at the Trip Winner's expense. If SG is unable to reschedule the reservation, the balance of the trip portion of the Trip Prize shall be forfeited, with the exception of the return air travel and \$1,000 spending money portion of the Trip Prize, less any withholdings, and the Proxy Procedures will apply.

Proxy Procedures: The following shall apply where a Trip Winner or Guest cannot participate in the GSE Event:

- a) SG will provide one (1) Proxy to participate on the Trip Winner's behalf and the Trip Winner will forego the right to personally participate in the GSE Event if:
 - i. The Trip Winner has a physical limitation that may prevent the Trip Winner from participating in the GSE Event, but still intends to attend the GSE Event; or
 - ii. The Trip Winner fails to arrive for his or her scheduled participation in the GSE Event;
- b) The Trip Winner shall receive any GSE Event Cash Prizes won by the Proxy, less applicable tax withholdings; and
- c) SG-assigned Proxies are selected from a pool of off-duty EMS workers, firefighters, and police personnel hired for the GSE Event.

Should any of the dates of the GSE Event change due to a Force Majeure event, Contractor shall work with the Trip Winners and the Lottery and use its best efforts to reschedule the fulfillment of the Trip Prize described above in accordance with the new GSE Event schedule.
